

**BY-LAW No. 53-00**

**THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF KANATA**

BEING a By-law to establish the rates, fees and charges for various city services delivered by the municipality.

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to establish rates, fees and charges for certain municipal services; and

WHEREAS there exists provincial statutes allowing the charging of rates, fees and charges for municipal services; and

WHEREAS By-law No. 48-81, 16-85, 22-85, 199-86, 187-87, 4-89, 56-89, 104-91, 9-92, 24-92, 26-92, 29-92, 41-92, 94-92, 8-93, 40-93, 105-93, 119-93, 155-93 and 144-99 set out the fees and charges for municipal services.

THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF KANATA HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the rates, fees and charges for various municipal services be established as shown in the schedules attached hereto, plus all federal and provincial taxes where applicable, as follows:
  - a) Schedule A - Corporate Services rates, fees and charges.
  - b) Schedule B - Planning & Development rates, fees and charges.
  - c) Schedule C - Protective Services rates, fees and charges.
  - d) Schedule D - Community & Recreation Services - Facilities rates, fees and charges;
  - e) Schedule E - Community & Recreation Services - Programs rates, fees and charges;
  - f) Schedule F - Community & Recreation Services - Aquatics rates, fees and charges;
  - g) Schedule G - Public Works rates fees and charges.
2. The fee schedules of the by-law law may be changes from time to time, as deemed desirable by amending the by-law as appropriate.
3. That Consolidated Rates and Fees By-law No. 78-99 be repealed.
4. This by-law shall come into effect on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of May 2000 with the exceptions of the effective dates as noted in each individual Schedule.
