DEPARTMENTAL RECOMMENDATION

That Planning and Environment Committee recommend that Council approve the appointment of the individual identified in Annex A as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer and amend By-law No. 3 of 1994 accordingly.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this report is to recommend the appointment of a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer to administer and enforce Part 5.2 (Sewers, Sewage Works and Control of Discharges) of the Regional Regulatory Code (the Sewer Use By-law).

DISCUSSION

Pursuant to Section 15 of the *Police Services Act*, Council may appoint Municipal Law Enforcement Officers to enforce its by-laws. To cover a temporary leave of absence, another individual has been retained to fulfil the Officer's duties.

Annex A sets out the name of the individual to be appointed as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer responsible for administration and enforcement of Part 5.2 of the Code.
