DEPARTMENTAL RECOMMENDATION

That the artistic assessors fee schedule in 2000 remain at the same level as 1999.

BACKGROUND

The Arts Grants Program consists of a review of applications by members of the arts community with extensive professional arts experience. Artistic Assessors are paid a fee for the time spent in arts assessor panel meetings as well as for preparation time.

HISTORY

In 1993 artistic assessors were paid at a rate of \$170 per day, this increased to \$175 per day in 1994 and remains at this rate. Application review fees have remained at the same level since 1993.

All artistic assessors receive a \$5.00 review fee for each application with the exception of literature applications who receive \$6.00 per application. One member of each arts assessor panel is asked to attend the Arts Committee Meeting to present their panel's recommendations. Each representative receives \$50.00 for this presentation.

The same rate of \$175.00 per day applies to artistic assessors for programs included in the Art in Public Spaces budget.

Payments for the Ottawa-Carleton Book Award are based on a \$200.00 honorarium plus a \$6.00 reading fee per book.

Funds will be included in the 2000 Regional Operating Budget for the 2000 Arts Grants assessment.
