For entry in 2000, the published book is to be:

- A non fiction book of literary merit;
- Have an original publishing date in the 1998 or 1999 calendar year; and
- Be written in English or French

- Entry is open to all authors residing in the Region of Ottawa-Carleton who are Canadian citizens or have landed immigrant status;
- Poetry is included in the fiction category;
- There are two, \$2,500 awards; one to a French author and one to an English author; and
- If the book is co-authored, one of the authors must reside in the Ottawa-Carleton Region.
