This letter is to inform you of my interest in a brief presentation to the Regional Community Services Committee when they next meet on Thursday September 16th at 1:30pm

The intention of this presentation is to introduce to the committee our new Centretown Laundry Co-operative, which I will be co-ordinating. Funded primarily by the Ottawa Presbytery of the United Church of Canada, the Good Neighbor Fund of St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church and the United Way of Ottawa-Carleton. This pilot project is a new and unique service targeting the financially and socially marginalized members of the Centretown community.

The Centretown Laundry Co-op was a need brought forth by the Peoples Hearings, which was created and mandated in partnership of community members McLeod Stewarton United Church, First United Church and Centretown CHC, and supported by the Community Services Committee. For this reason, it was thought it would be in the best interest of the committee to see such a community project come to fruition.

The Co-op is targeted to unofficially open on the 14th of September.
