HOME ADVISORY COMMITTEES**

DEPARTMENTAL RECOMMENDATION

That Community Services Committee appoint a member to the position of Chair of each of the three Home Advisory Committees.

BACKGROUND

The mandate of the Home Advisory Committees is to provide a formal link between the Home and the Community Services Committee. The Home Advisory Committees receive regular reports on the operation of the facilities and provide a community perspective on issues.

The membership of the Committees includes: Chair, a member of the Community Services Committee, two community advisory members, representatives of the Residents' Council, Family Association, Auxilliary, the Medical Director, Homes for the Aged Commissioner, and the Executive Director (Secretary).

The Committees meet on an average of three times a year. The meetings are usually one to one and a half hours long and are held in the Home.

The appointments are for the term of Council.
