## **DEPARTMENTAL RECOMMENDATION**

That two members of the Corporate Services and Economic Development Committee volunteer to form a sub-committee to review applications and recommend a candidate for the Ottawa-Carleton Regional Housing Authority appointment.

### **BACKGROUND**

The Regional Municipality of Ottawa-Carleton is responsible for nominating four public representatives to the Ottawa-Carleton Regional Housing Authority for varying terms. At present, the individuals and their respective terms are as follows:

The Ministry of Housing's Ontario Housing Corporation has advised that one of the Region's representatives on the Ottawa-Carleton Regional Housing Authority, Mr. Chris Arnold's, term has expired and he is not eligible for re-appointment as he has served the maximum of six years. They have therefore requested that the RMOC seek a new appointee to represent the Regional Municipality of Ottawa-Carleton on the Housing Authority for a two year term.

Mssrs. Guénette and Heavens are eligible for re-appointment for a two year term, as they have just completed their first term with the Regional Housing Authority.

Public notices advertising the vacancy will appear in <u>The Citizen, The Sun and Le Droit</u> on 14 and 15 February 1998. In addition, all members of Council have received a memo advising of

the vacancy in case they know of someone who might be interested. The deadline for receipt of resumés is Friday, 27 February 1998.

A sub-committee of two members of the Corporate Services and Economic Development Committee is required to review the applications received, and to make a recommendation to the Committee and Council.

### **PUBLIC CONSULTATION**

Public consultation is not applicable to the establishment of the sub-committee. Public notices advertising the vacancy will appear in <u>The Citizen</u>, <u>The Sun and Le Droit</u> on 14 and 15 February 1998.

### **FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS**

Financial implications are not associated with the establishment of the sub-committee. Financial implications associated with the cost of advertising are included in the Regional Clerk's Department budget.
