INTRODUCTION

BACKGROUND

Tenders were called for Contract 97-535 for the relocation of the mechanical/electrical plant servicing part of the Canadian Museum of Contemporary Photography. This relocation was required to facilitate repairs to the underside of the east arch of the Plaza Bridge. The intention was to carry out this work by 28 November 1997, in advance of the main contract for the rehabilitation of the Plaza Bridge.

As a consequence of the single tender over estimate, the Department has included the work for the relocation of the mechanical/electrical plant into the tender for the main contract for the Plaza Bridge.
