The Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing, under Section 7(2) of the Housing Development Act (R.S.O. 1990, c.H.18), recommends to the Lieutenant Governor in Council nominations for appointment to the Province's Local Housing Authority boards.

As you may be aware, the government recently announced its intention to devolve responsibility for administration and funding of social housing to the municipalities.
