• Replace "In the event that the Region does not elect to exercise any purchase option noted above, a rail plant sufficient for freight operations will be left in place at the conclusion of the lease that is not of a lesser quality than exists currently. All other salvage will be to the credit of the Region" with "In the event that the Region does not elect to exercise any purchase option noted above, or terminates the leases prior to their conclusions, a rail plant sufficient for freight operations will be left in place that is not of a lesser quality than exists currently. Salvage during the construction of initial improvements to the subject lands shall be to the account of CPR. All other salvage will be to the credit of the Region"
