 REVOCATION OF CONSENT**

DEPARTMENTAL RECOMMENDATION

That the Planning and Environment Committee recommend that Council approve the revocation of the Consent dated 26 May 1993, for Francis Waste Management Ltd. for the operation of a liquid waste transfer facility located at 39 Cleopatra Drive, Nepean, Ontario.

DISCUSSION

On 26 May 1993, Regional Council granted a Consent with no conditions to Francis Waste Management Ltd. to operate a liquid waste transfer facility. This firm no longer requires a Consent as it has ceased to operate.

Consents that are now granted include a revocation clause that takes effect when the company ceases to operate. Since Francis Waste Management Ltd.'s Consent did not contain this clause, this report is required for administrative reasons.

CONSULTATION

Consultation is not required with respect to Regional Municipality of Ottawa-Carleton (RMOC) Consents.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The revocation of Consents has no financial impact on the RMOC.

CONCLUSION

That the Planning and Environment Committee recommend Council approve the revocation of Francis Waste Management Ltd.'s Consent dated 26 May 1993, for the operation of a liquid waste transfer facility located at 39 Cleopatra Drive, Nepean, Ontario.
