## **REPORT RECOMMENDATION**

That \$10,500.00 be provided from the budget for Traffic Calming for the projects outlined in the report.

### BACKGROUND

The City of Ottawa has developed a list of priorities for traffic calming measures constructed in conjunction with planned road reconstruction projects for 1997. City Councillor Elisabeth Arnold has requested Regional partnership on the work being performed that affect Regional roads. The locations to be calmed and a brief description of the work to be completed are:

### Somerset at LeBreton - \$6,000.00

Trucks are using LeBreton Street as a shortcut from Gladstone to Somerset instead of the appropriate regional roads. LeBreton Street is wide at the intersection with Somerset Street and as a result vehicles make the turn at too fast a speed, without slowing down sufficiently on Somerset Street or stopping completely on LeBreton Street. The intersection narrowing proposed for this intersection will result in vehicles going through this intersection more slowly, and may discourage some of the cut-through truck traffic. The narrowing will also provide a shorter area for pedestrians to cross on Somerset Street.

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Metcalfe at MacLaren - \$3,000.00

The narrowing proposed for the northeast side of Maclaren Street is intended to discourage the trucks that are cutting down this residential street to travel north on Metcalfe Street. Both narrowings will protect the parked cars on the north side of Maclaren, and provide a safer pedestrian crossing.

Metcalfe at Frank, southeast corner - \$1,500.00

This intersection is offset and there are a significant number of vehicles making an illegal southbound movement on Metcalfe in order to continue west along Frank. The narrowing at this intersection is intended to prevent this vehicular movement and make the intersection safer for pedestrians.

**CONSULTATION** 

The City of Ottawa advertised these projects in the Ottawa Citizen. A copy of the advertisement is attached.








1. Proposed Measures on Maclaren Street





2. Proposed Measures on Frank Street






3. Proposed Measures on Percy Street




4. Proposed Measures Adjacent to Somerset Street




5. Proposed Measures on Primrose Avenue
