6. STUDENT AGE CAP FOR OC TRANSPO FARES

WHEREAS, the new age structure for OC Transpo is designed to align with other transit agencies participating in the Presto program,

AND WHEREAS, this results in a common and standard maximum age of 19 to be eligible for individual student passes (except for U-Pass),

AND WHEREAS, City Council's decision did not anticipate the various scenarios that adversely impact students,

AND WHEREAS, this "Made In Toronto" solution does not serve our student population equitably and fairly,

BE IT THEREFORE Resolved that the student age be amended to recognize full time students; AND

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$400,000 be taken from the Transit Reserves to offset the associated cost for the remainder of 2012.
